 on behalf of my child and any other accompanying minor(s) assume any and all risk and damage or injury while on The
 Maine Jump premises.
- 2. I am aware of the risk, hazards and danger of personal injury, disability and/or death as a result of participation at The Maine Jump, including those that may arise out of negligence or conduct of other participants. Also, if I discover any hazard during our participation, I will bring it to the attention of the nearest Maine Jump employee immediately.

By the execution of this agreement, it is my intention to assume all risk of injury and do hereby surrender and waive any rights to sue or exercise any legal right to seek damages against Hatch Family Enterprises, LLC., d/b/a The Maine Jump, its owners, agents, employees, officers, directors and/or all other persons or entities acting on its behalf.
